The Government of Liberia (GoL) has signed financing agreements for Grants/Concessionary loans from three donor partners including the Government of Norway, the European Investment Bank (EIB), and KfW Development Bank (KfW) for the rehabilitation of the 60-80 MW hydropower generating plant at Mount Coffee, in Liberia.

This International Invitation for Tendering with Pre-Qualification relates to the **Main Civil Works Contract 2A for the Rehabilitation of the Mount Coffee Hydropower Plant**. This contract will include: re-construction of the main dam and rehabilitation of the existing ones, powerhouse, spillway and intake rehabilitation works, infrastructure and road works.

This contract is expected to be implemented from January 2015 to December 2016. The works will be executed under FIDIC Red Book conditions.

The criteria to be used in the Pre-Qualification evaluation are: Experience in the successful completion of similar projects, financial situation, and historical contract performance.
